

# CAMP POLICIES

- 1)** Army Expo '23 is a two day event and payment of units and demonstrators is contingent on participation both days. Payment will be prorated accordingly for units who do not participate completely for both days. All participants must check in at the registration tent (see map) and receive a roster in order to be paid for the event. It is required that the unit leader sign in and give a head count for the unit. ALL participants must stop at registration tent and have weapons checked.
- 2)** Set-up times are Friday 1200 noon to Saturday morning at 8:00 am. There is no set-up during the public hours on Saturday. We ask that all vehicles be removed upon set-up and no vehicle will be allowed in the camp area after 8:00 am Saturday. You can walk your equipment in after 8:00 am.
- 3)** Once set-up you will then proceed to the designated re-enactor parking area (see enclosed map). Any vehicles parked in the Handicapped/VIP lot will be removed after one warning. It is strongly recommended that participants park immediately after unloading.
- 4)** Those individuals and groups coming in on Friday evening after dark may keep their vehicles in camp on Friday night but they must be removed to the parking area on Saturday morning before 8:00 am.
- 5)** No vehicle will be allowed in the camp area to load out before 5:30 pm on Sunday. All re-enactors must follow designated vehicle routes (see enclosed map.) If you need to depart before 5:30 pm then you must carry out your gear. Federal regulations prohibit the use of Federal vehicles for this purpose. If there is an emergency that requires your departure, then please notify one of the staff and we will have appropriate authorities assist you. No vehicles will be allowed on the trail during the public hours for safety reasons.
- 6)** FIRES ARE ALLOWED; fire regulations for the buildings are in effect. Regardless of location, there can be no unattended fires at any time. A water bucket must be kept by each fire. No person can be asleep in any building while a fire is burning. The fire department will be checking in the evening.
- 7)** Alcohol use is not allowed during public hours. It is strongly discouraged at the site as it is a federal facility.
